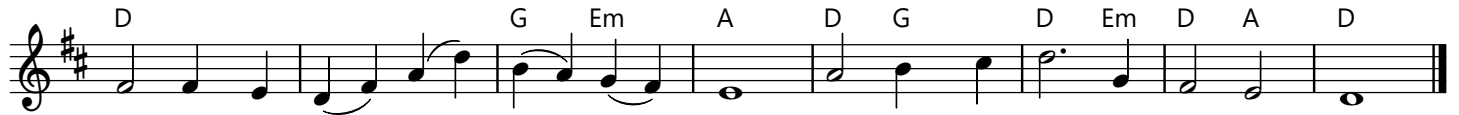


Jesus Shall Reign Where'er the Sun
