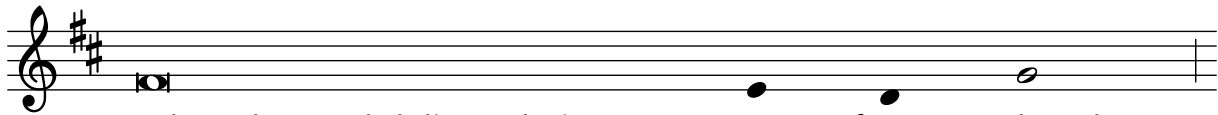

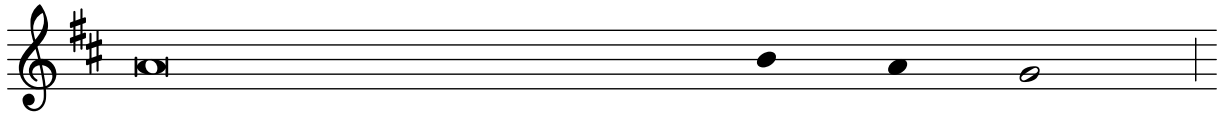

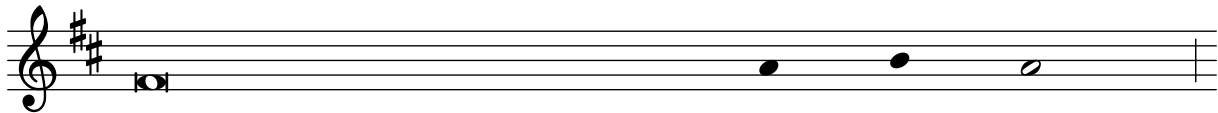
Psalm 126 (125): 1-2b, 2c-3, 4-5, 6



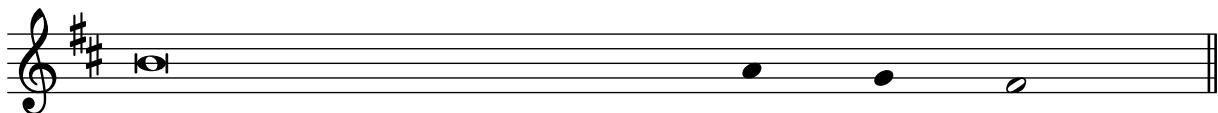
1. When the Lord delivered Zi - on from bondage,
