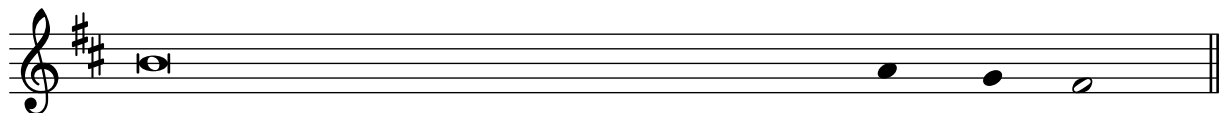
1. I will praise you, Lord, you have rescued me
