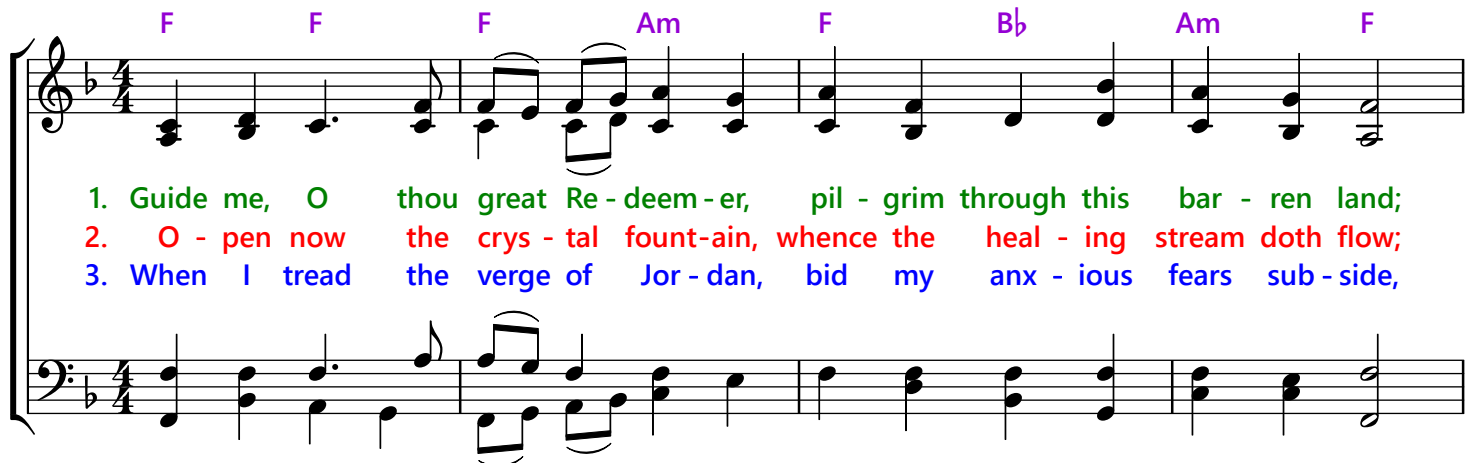

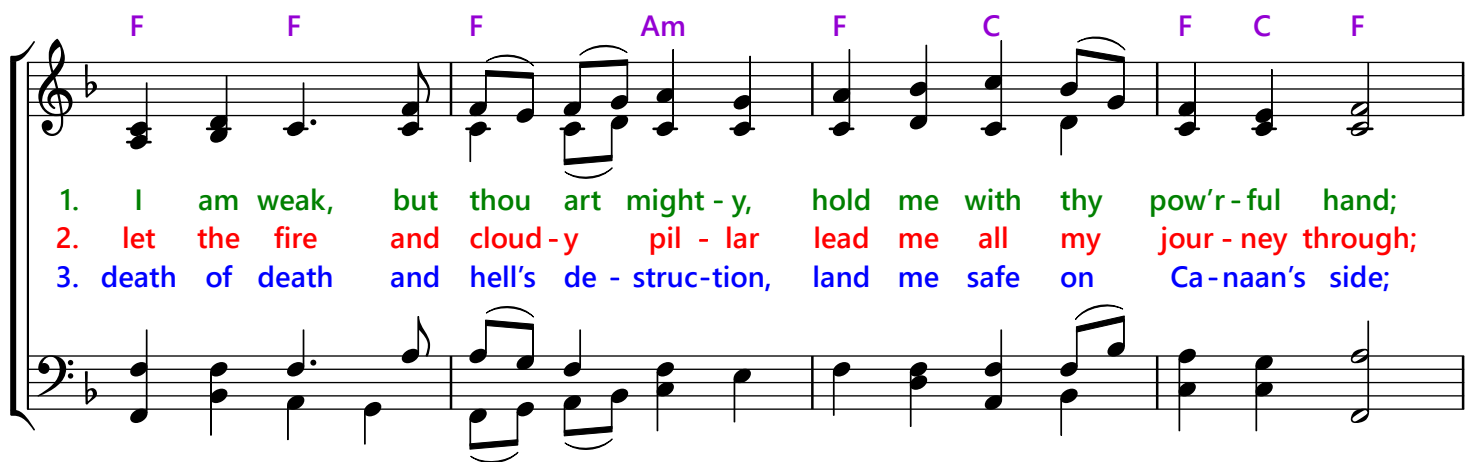

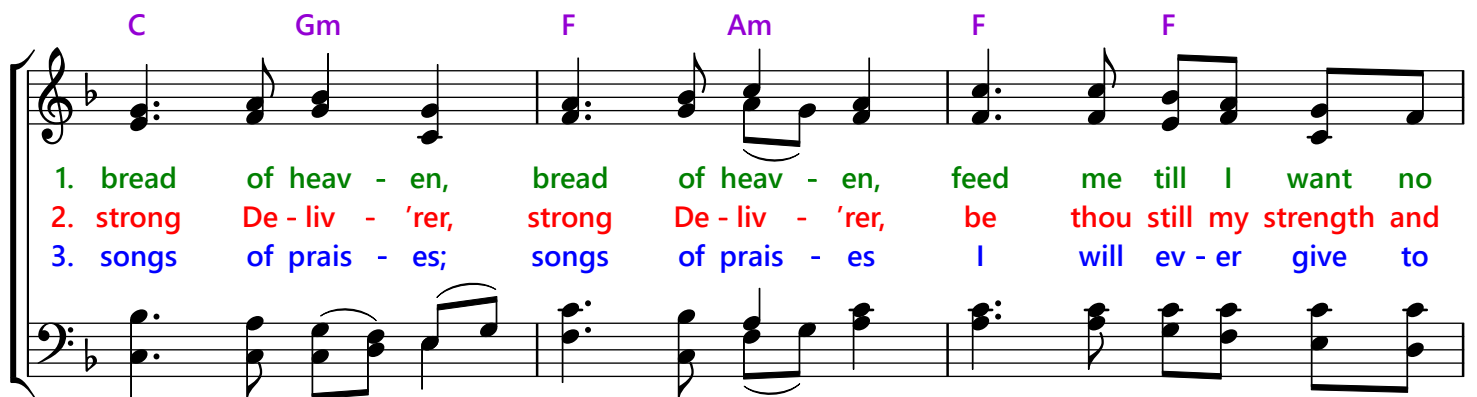
1. Guide me, O thou great Re-deem-er, pil-grim through this bar-ren land;

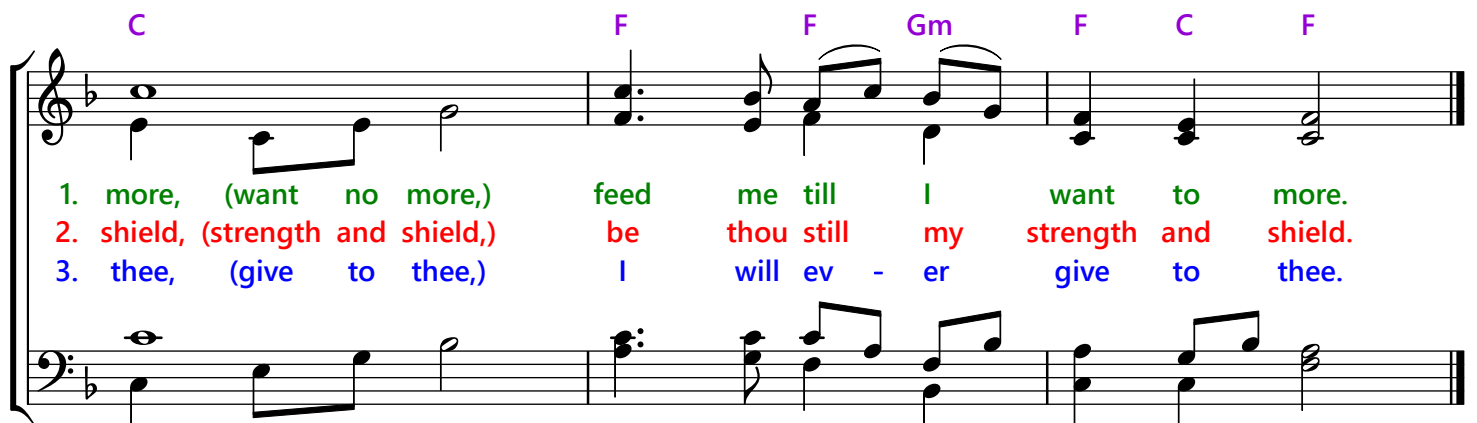
1. I am weak, but thou art might-y, hold me with thy pow'r-ful hand;
