


Psalm 66 (65): 1

Psalm 66 (65): 1-3a, 4-5, 6-7a, 16+20



1. Cry out with joy to God, all **the earth**;

O render him **glorious praise**.
Say to God: 'How **wondrous your deeds!**'
2. 'Before you all the earth shall **bow down**,
shall sing to you, sing **to your name!**'
