


Psalm 66 (65): 1




R. Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 7

Psalm 66 (65): 1-3a, 4-5, 6-7a, 16+20



1. Cry out with joy to God, all the earth; O sing to the glory of his name.
 2. 'Before you all the earth shall bow; shall sing to you, sing to your name!'
 3. He turned the sea in - to dry land; they passed through the riv - er dry - shod.
 4. Come and hear, all who fear God. I will tell what he did for my soul.

 2. Come and see the works of God, tremendous his deeds a - mong men.
 3. Let our joy then be in him; he rules for ever by his might.
